Past trips have had from 67 to 152 sailfish caught in the three days of fishing. You too can have this adventure!

We have again reserved the services of Pacific Fins Resort and Marina to deliver a top-notch experience. Pacific Fins is really the only true luxury fishing resort in Guatemala. Their boutique hotel with private villas provides an all-inclusive experience for the duration of your trip. After a breakfast at the resort, there will be another day of fishing. After we return to the resort in the afternoon, we will enjoy watching the Super Bowl on a large flat screen TV in the Open-Air Bar. A special Super Bowl dinner will be served. (B,L,D)

Day 5 – Departure and Travel

We will wake up early and travel back to the airport for our departure home. (B)

Trip Cost: \$3,500 per person
